

Use the Cricut Easy Press to quickly and easily adhere iron-on vinyl or sublimation prints to a variety of surfaces.

- 1** For vinyl: design, create, and cut your iron-on image in Cricut Design Space. For sublimation: use the Sublimation Printer guide to print your image using sublimation ink.
Both iron-on vinyl and sublimation photos must be mirrored!
- 2** Place your decal or photo on your surface. Use heat-resistant tape to hold it in place.
- 3** Consult the [Easy Press Heat](https://cricut.com/en_us/heatguide) guide (https://cricut.com/en_us/heatguide) and review the simple directions for pre-heating your material, temperature, timing and pressure. Or, use the settings suggested on the package/tag of your material if it has this information.
- 4** Sublimation ink can bleed through your material. Put blank paper inside your shirt/bag etc. to prevent this.
- 5** Set the temperature and timer to the desired settings and wait for the button to turn green. Once the button is green, lift the Easy Press onto your project.
- 6** Press the green button to start the timer. The numbers will count down as you maintain the required pressure. Once the machine beeps, your heat press is complete or you are free to move the press to another area.
- 7** Place the press back in it's holder and follow the directions for a hot or cold peel based on the materials you are using.
- 8** Remember to unplug the machine when you are finished and wait at least a day before washing your creation (if necessary).
