


Requirements

1. **Create an EBSCOHost Account.** Go to the following webpage:
<http://bit.ly/1IeyDVt>
(you may be asked for your library card number and PIN)
Then click **Sign In** at the top of the screen and **Create New Account**
2. **Download Adobe Digital Editions** to your computer from:
www.adobe.com/ca/solutions/ebook/digital-editions.html
3. **Create an Adobe ID.** Go to the following webpage:
<http://adobe.ly/1CsyG3A>
Keep a note of your ID (email address & password).

Searching for ebooks

1. Go to Barrie Public Library website:
www.barriepubliclibrary.ca
Search for your ebook in the online catalogue.
You may filter search results to show only **EBooks** in the **Refine by** menu on the left of the results page
2. EBSCOHost ebooks have the following link under the title:

3. Click this link to go to the e-book on the EBSCOHost website

Checking out and downloading

1. From the ebook record on the EBSCOHost website, you can click **PDF Full Text** to read it online or **Download This eBook** to save a copy to your computer
2. You may be prompted to sign in or register for a personal EBSCOHost account
3. You can choose the loan period (1- 21 days)

4. Then click on **Checkout & Download**.
5. The ebook will download and should open in your preferred e-book reader software.

Managing your EBSCOHost e-books

- When signed in to the EBSCOHost eBook Collection website you can click on **My Checkouts**, in the top right corner, to view your e-books
- You can also save books to your folder for later
- Once you have downloaded an ebook you can transfer it to an ebook reader in the normal way using **Adobe Digital Editions**.
You may be prompted for your Adobe ID and password.
